Directions

From the South

via PA-51 and the Liberty Tunnel, including Brentwood, Pleasant Hills, Elizabeth Township, and Uniontown

Take PA-51 to the Liberty Tunnel. Follow the signs to Downtown and I-579 in the left of two right turn lanes. Stay in the left lane through the tunnel and then move to the right lane as you proceed across the bridge after the tunnel. Exit right from the bridge toward Oakland and Boulevard of the Allies. Continue toward Oakland and exit right to Forbes Avenue. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.

From the North and Northwest

via I-79 and I-279, including Butler, Mars, Erie, Youngstown, OH, and Cleveland, OH

Take I-79 South to I-279 South. Follow I-279 South to Exit 6A. This will take you to I-376 East, heading toward Monroeville. Exit from I-376 at Exit 2A to Forbes Avenue and Oakland. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.

From the East

via I-376, including Monroeville, Irwin, Penn Hills, Altoona, and Greensburg

Take I-376 West (which originates at Exit 57 from the Pennsylvania Turnpike and merges with US-22). Stay on I-376 West and take Exit 3B to Oakland and Bates Street. Continue straight on Bates Street until it ends at Bouquet Street. Turn left onto Bouquet Street and continue to Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.

From the Southwest and West

via I-279 and the Fort Pitt Tunnel, including Pittsburgh International Airport, Washington, Moon Township, Morgantown, WV, and Columbus, OH

Take I-79, PA-60, or US-22/30 to I-376/I-279 to Pittsburgh. Continue on I-279 through the Fort Pitt Tunnel in the right lane. After the tunnel, follow the exit to I-376 East and Monroeville. Exit from I-376 at Exit 2A to Forbes Avenue and Oakland. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.

From Downtown (Three Options)

1. From Grant Street, take I-376 East and Monroeville. Exit from I-376 at Exit 2A to Forbes Avenue and Oakland. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.
2. Take the Boulevard of the Allies. Continue toward Oakland and exit to Forbes Avenue. Continue on Forbes Avenue until you see Carnegie Museums and Library on your right. Dippy, the life-size statue of our *Diplodocus*, stands at the beginning of the buildings. At the traffic light located at Forbes Avenue and South Craig Street, turn right into our parking facility.
3. For public transportation, take the 61A, B, or C transit bus, which you can board at signed stops along Fifth Avenue. A popular stop is at the corner of Fifth Avenue and Wood Street. Ask the driver to let you know when you have reached the stop closest to Carnegie Museums in Oakland. Note: exact change is required for the transit fare.

Public Transportation

Bus routes 61A, B, and C, and 67A, C, E, F, and J stop directly in front of the museums on Forbes Avenue. Routes 71B, C, and D stop one block north of the museums at the intersection of Fifth Avenue and South Craig Street. Bus 54C stops on South Craig Street between Forbes Avenue and Fifth Avenue.
